Creative Movement: Plain Lt. Blue leotard, pink tights with feet, pink ballet slippers. No skirts or leg warmers. Hair should be pulled away from the face and off the neck. Please have your teacher check your ballet slippers for a proper fit.

Preparatory: Plain lavender leotard, pink tights with feet, pink ballet slippers. No skirts or leg warmers. Hair should be pulled away from the face and off the neck. Please have your teacher check your ballet slippers for a proper fit.

Primary 1&2: Plain light pink leotard, pink tights with feet, pink ballet slippers. No skirts or leg warmers. Hair should be pulled away from the face and off the neck. Please have your teacher check your ballet slippers for a proper fit.

Girls/Ladies: Solid color leotard, (Elementary 1 in black), pink tights with feet, pink ballet slippers. No skirts or leg warmers except for adult students. Hair should be pulled away from the face and neck and secured tightly to the head. No ponytails. Please have your teacher check your ballet slippers for a proper fit. Beginning pointe students MUST have their shoes approved before ribbons are sewn. Large dangle earrings, chunky jewelry and t-shirts are not permitted.

Boys/Men: Solid white T-shirt, black tights or shorts, black or white ballet shoes. All males, 10 and older must wear a dance belt.
